



INVESTMENT OBJECTIVE

The Fund is a multi-asset, globally diversified portfolio investing in equities, bonds, property, and money market instruments without restriction. It does not impose target bands across any of these classes and may deviate materially from its benchmark (50% equities, 30% bonds, and 20% money market). We seek to achieve our investment objective of long-term capital growth with an acceptable level of risk through an actively-managed portfolio of assets, spread over a broad range of asset classes, currencies, and geographies in varying proportions over time. The Fund should be viewed as a medium to long term investment.



FUND MANAGER COMMENTARY - JANUARY 2024

The Flagship International Flexible Fund returned -0.7% vs its composite benchmark which was up 0.2% (both in USD), as global markets started the new year on a mixed note.

The biggest contributors for the month were Hensoldt and Tapestry, while the main detractors were Concentrix and Blue Label.

INVESTMENT COMMENTARY

After ending 2023 on a strong note, global equity indices delivered a mixed start to 2024. In the US, both the S&P 500 and Nasdag improved by 1.7% and 1.0% respectively. The Russell 2000 had a tough start to the year. though, dropping by 3.9%. In the UK, the FTSE 100 fell 1.3%, while in the Asia there were vastly different results on opposite sides of the East China Sea. Japan's Nikkei gained 8.4%, while Hong Kong's Hang Seng index lost 9.2%.

The latest US CPI reading showed an uptick, increasing by 3.4% on a yearover-year basis (forecast at 3.2% and December at 3.1%), contributing to the Fed's more cautious commentary on the prospects of near-term rate cuts. January has delivered some signs of weakness in the job market, though, with UPS alone announcing 12,000 job cuts. The Fed continues its tightrope balancing act between taming inflation and maximum employment.

In US politics, the race for the top 2 nominees is as good as done. Donald Trump started the primaries strongly, winning both lowa and New Hampshire.

This led to his main rival, Florida Governor Ron deSantis, dropping out very early in the race, and almost guaranteeing Trump the position of Republican nominee. Reports have emerged that Trump is targeting a massive trade war with China if re-elected as president. This would obviously cause ripple effects across global markets.

The US is one of more than 50 countries holding elections this year - in what is being billed as one of the biggest election years in history. Taiwan kicked off the year with a victory for the pro-democracy (and thus anti-China) party, representing another blow to the struggling Chinese economy, which is reeling from its property sector crisis, rising unemployment and subdued economic growth. The ruling Communist Party have tried a number of approaches to stem the subsequent bleeding in its stock market and bolster the economy, but these efforts have largely failed.
